



## **Ashtons Pharmacy Donates Vital Medicine to Mozambique**

Ashtons Late Night Pharmacy, located in the Seven Dials area of Brighton, has provided much needed medicines to a refugee camp in Mozambique that will help to relieve the suffering of the refugees for many months.

Situated in the North Eastern province of Mozambique, the camp consists of 7000 people, many of whom fled from upheaval and atrocities in Rwanda, Burundi, Zimbabwe and the Congo.

There are huge problems when someone falls ill with a fever and the medicines supplied by Ashtons will greatly alleviate this suffering.

Ashtons' Managing Director, Laurence Sprey, said "When you see the conditions these people are under I just had to donate some of our stock to help".

Mark Tailyour, a charity worker who helps with teaching at the camp, comments "It's hard to put into words what this means, it will literally save lives"
